

Entry Requirements for Classical Scholarship Program Year 2

Overview:

Applicants must demonstrate foundational proficiency in Arabic grammar and morphology. Specifically, they are expected to have completed the following:

- 1) Successful Completion of Madinah Arabic Book 1 or equivalent.
- 2) In addition, applicants should be able to read, translate, and comprehend the content of Madinah Arabic Book 1. This includes a working knowledge of the 'Core Arabic Grammar Content' covered in Year 1 of the Classical Scholarship Programme at Al-Ma'rifa Institute, as outlined below:
